For Students Enrolled in a Virtual Class: Each participant will need to set up two (2) computers in order to take the class virtually.

1. The first can be a PC, tablet or Mac.
2. The second computer should be a Mac and you will need the software (and version) being taught in the course already installed on your computer.

This setup will allow virtual students to view the presentation on one computer and do support exercises on the other one.
